## BRIEF DESCRIPTION OF THE ROLE:

To manage, follow up, and organize communication, coordination, collaboration, and activities with the internal and external stakeholders of the faculty.

## **DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:**

- The Stakeholder Committee and its members are appointed by the Dean and carry out their activities upon approval by the Faculty Administrative Board
- To establish communication for the work and activities to be carried out with internal and external stakeholders.
- To create necessary protocols or other requirements for the planned activities and tasks.
- To define the content of activities and organizations.
- To carry out necessary actions for the implementation of activities and tasks, including follow-up and organization.
- To monitor whether the provisions of the agreements made with stakeholders are being fulfilled.
- To track the validity period of the agreements and any changes to be made, and to ensure their renewal.
- To prepare surveys to be conducted with stakeholders, have stakeholders complete them, evaluate the surveys at least once a year, and send the results report to the Dean's Office.
- Committee members continue in their roles until a new appointment is made.
- In the event that a committee member leaves for any reason, a new member will be appointed by the Dean's Office.
- Committee members are required to attend meetings unless they present an officially recognized excuse.
- The situation of members who fail to attend meetings without providing documented justification will be evaluated by the Dean's Office.
